## **Dihydralazine Mesilate (Nepresol) Administration**

Intravenous dihydralazine is not currently available in South Africa (not registered by SAPHRA) and usage is subject to Section 21 of the Medicines and Related

Substance Act.

#### 1. LOADING DOSAGES:

#### 1.1. <u>Loading dose</u>

- 25mg Dihydralazine diluted in 20ml normal saline (1,25mg/ml solution)
- 1ml (1,25mg Dihydralazine) slow IV bolus over 2-5min
- Fall in BP anticipated within 10 20 minutes and lasts from two to four hours
- Can be repeated in intervals of >30min

#### 1.2. Continuous Infusion

- 100mg (4 ampoules) in 200ml Saline [0,5mg/ml Solution]
- **Initial** infusion rate 10ml/hour (5mg Dihydralazine/hour), then titrate by 2ml/hour (1mg/hour) increments over 30min
- Max Infusion of 40ml/hour (20mg Dihydralazine/hour)

### Informed consent and a progress report must be filed for every patient.
