

Partogram exercise- to complete on an empty partogram

- 41 year old G5 P3 M1 at 40 weeks, attended clinic only once, booked late. HIV-, VDRL -, Rh +. Admitted in labour; examined on 1 January 2020 at 14h00 with three strong contractions in 10 minutes.
- Membranes ruptured spontaneously on 1 January 2020 at 05h00 and contractions started at 06h00. Clear fluid draining on speculum examination
- BP 100/60; pulse 67/min, urine (100 ml passed): 2+ leukocytes, 2+nitrates, 1+ blood, no glucose, no protein, no ketones. Temperature 37°C
- Fetal heart rate 140/min before contraction and 140 bpm after contraction
- Abdomen: term, singleton, longitudinal lie, cephalic presentation, back on left side, 2/5 HAB
- Vaginal examination: cervix fully effaced, 6 cm dilated, LOA, no caput, no moulding, application good.
